FPTA Supports:

Creation of a Rural Transit Operating Trust Fund

- FPTA urges the Florida Legislature to create a Rural Transit Operating Trust Fund within the Florida Department of Transportation.
- The Rural Transit Operating Trust Fund would allow rural operators, and those with rural parts of their county, to better serve their communities.
- Many Rural Transit Operators can only bill when service is provided; therefore, when service is interrupted (such as a natural disaster or pandemic), their revenue drops and it's difficult to retain employees and properly account for regular expenses of the organization.

Closely Monitoring all Transportation-Related Transportation

- FPTA will closely monitor all transportation legislation to ensure integrity of our public transit systems.
- FPTA will work with legislators to negotiate amendment language when legislation is filed that affects public transit.
